The two stay-made beds have privacy curtains and thick foam mattresses as good as home. All this living can be buttoned down in minutes to a compact unit that travels easily behind your car at turn-pike speeds with no sway or pull. You can set it up in minutes. There's even wall-to-wall carpeting and an electrical outlet. The hard Polymer travel cover doubles as a roof that is high overhead, no need to stoop. The cozy dinette transforms into an even cozier bunk and there's enough storage space to make any woman happy. Even with all these home-like surroundings, when the fiberglass screened windows are open on four sides, you're living outdoors... but in comfort! The rust-free anodized aluminum trailer body is double-wall constructed. The rear panel houses four large tail lamps. There ought to be a better word than "camping" to describe living in a Golden Buffalo. Maybe that's the word, "living."

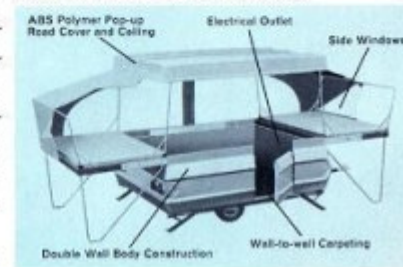

Everything is laid out with such work-saving efficiency. Notice how close the icebox is to the trailer door, easy to load or unload. The sink, stove, dinette and storage space are close enough to

each other to make setting a table or cleaning up after a meal a breeze. From this angle the Buffalo looks like a house trailer. It does have the same conveniences, but not the inconvenience of hauling a cumbersome bulk behind. The Golden Buffalo pulls easily. You hardly know it's there.

APACHE Golden Eagle. Maybe there's no place like home, but a Golden Eagle comes mighty close. You enjoy its conveniences even on the highway. Especially when you see tent campers, stuff piled on top of their car, always stopping to check the straps. Not so in a Golden Eagle. Everything, but *everything* stores neatly inside. Outside is a streamlined unit that follows behind your car like the trunk, but with a lot more storage space. So light even a woman can handle it. Takes only minutes to set up for comfy living, and the living is easy. Room enough for four six-footers to stand upright, or lie down on the double beds, or sleep several more with an Add-A-Room or Screen Enclosure. Thick foam mattresses and a cool breeze coming through the four big fiberglass screened windows would lull a night owl to sleep. Don't restrict the family in what they bring. The hard Polymer travel top, same material as football helmets, separates and becomes two enormous storage drawers on either side of the trailer. Between the beds is a 3-way divided cabinet that's a marvel of versatility. The top is a handy place to put a lamp and clock and the hinged door lets down to act as a shelf. Tenting is preshrunk treated Army Duck that shrugs off water and mildew. The trailer floor has wall-to-wall, nylon-blend carpeting. There's even a handy electrical outlet.
