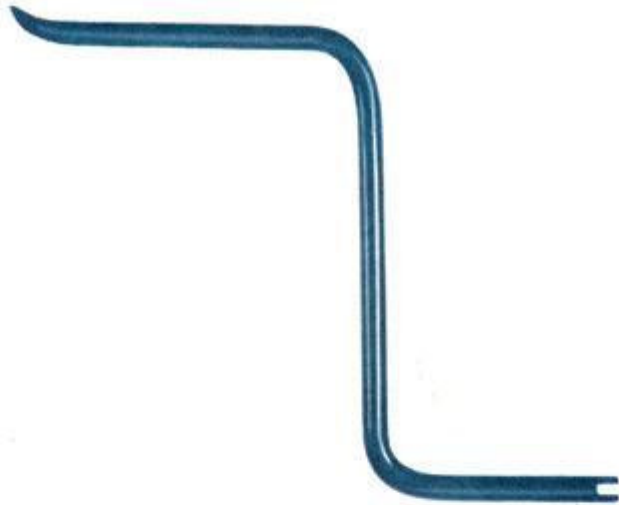

Our new crank is the easiest, most reliable way to put up a camping trailer. The crank fits into any one of the four corners. It only takes a few turns (about 10) and the beds go out. While the road cover automatically goes up to become the roof. The Ramada features a new, self-storing screen door that drops into place when you set up. All four Adjust-A-Level legs have built-in jacks, if leveling's necessary. There's a double-panel door that flips down into a convenient step. And electric brakes make it the safest trailer on the road.

Inside the Ramada, you'll find everything you could pos-

sibly want in a camping trailer. And all of this is standard equipment. Sleeping room for eight. Smart wood trim. Cabinet with sink and range built in. Ice box. A family-size dinette that seats six six-footers, and converts easily into a double bed. And gaucho couch that quickly makes into another bed.
